Membership Criteria

Membership in a Soroptimist Club is by Invitation. Care is taken to ensure that each club represents a wide range of occupations. Members are chosen for their individual qualities as well as their status in their chosen area of work.

To be eligible for membership, a woman should be:

- Working in a business or profession or an occupation of comparable status or responsibilities to those of person working in a business or profession.
- Retired from or temporarily or permanently out of work from a business or profession or occupation of comparable status or responsibilities to those of a person working in a profession or business.
- Embarking on a career in a profession or business or occupation of comparable status or responsibilities to those of a person working in a profession or business.
